Reminder: UCB and OB Recipients

If you are receiving the Unsupported Child or Ophan's benefit for a child or the children in your care, don't forget that you can apply for extra supports to help cover the costs of raising the children.

Extraordinary Care Fund

You can apply for up to \$2,000 per child for a range of costs not covered within the weekly UCB/OB payments or other supports that may be available. See our website for guidelines. It has been confirmed by the Ministry of Social Development (MSD) that the cut-off date for the Extraordinary Care Fund for February 2021 will be the 19th February 2021

School and Year Start-Up Payment

You can also get a **School and Year Start-Up Payment** for each child in your care. Apply mid-January to end of February. Payment will be made within 10 working days. See the table of current rates below.

Age of child (at end of February)	Payment
0 - 4 years	\$400
5 - 9 years	\$450
10 - 13 years	\$500
14 years and over	\$550

























Are you raising someone else's child?

If you are because there has been a breakdown in the child's family and you are likely to be their principal caregiver for at least 1 year from the date you apply to Work and Income for this support, then you are entitled to this support to help with the costs of raising the child.

The Unsupported Child Benefit is not taxable and is not affected by your income or assets as a caregiver. It is affected by any income the child might be receiving (e.g. ACC) and the child must be resident and present in NZ.

To qualify for it you must also be over 18 years of age, resident and present in NZ for a continuous period of 12 months or more and you must not be a natural parent, an adoptive parent, or a step-parent of the child.
